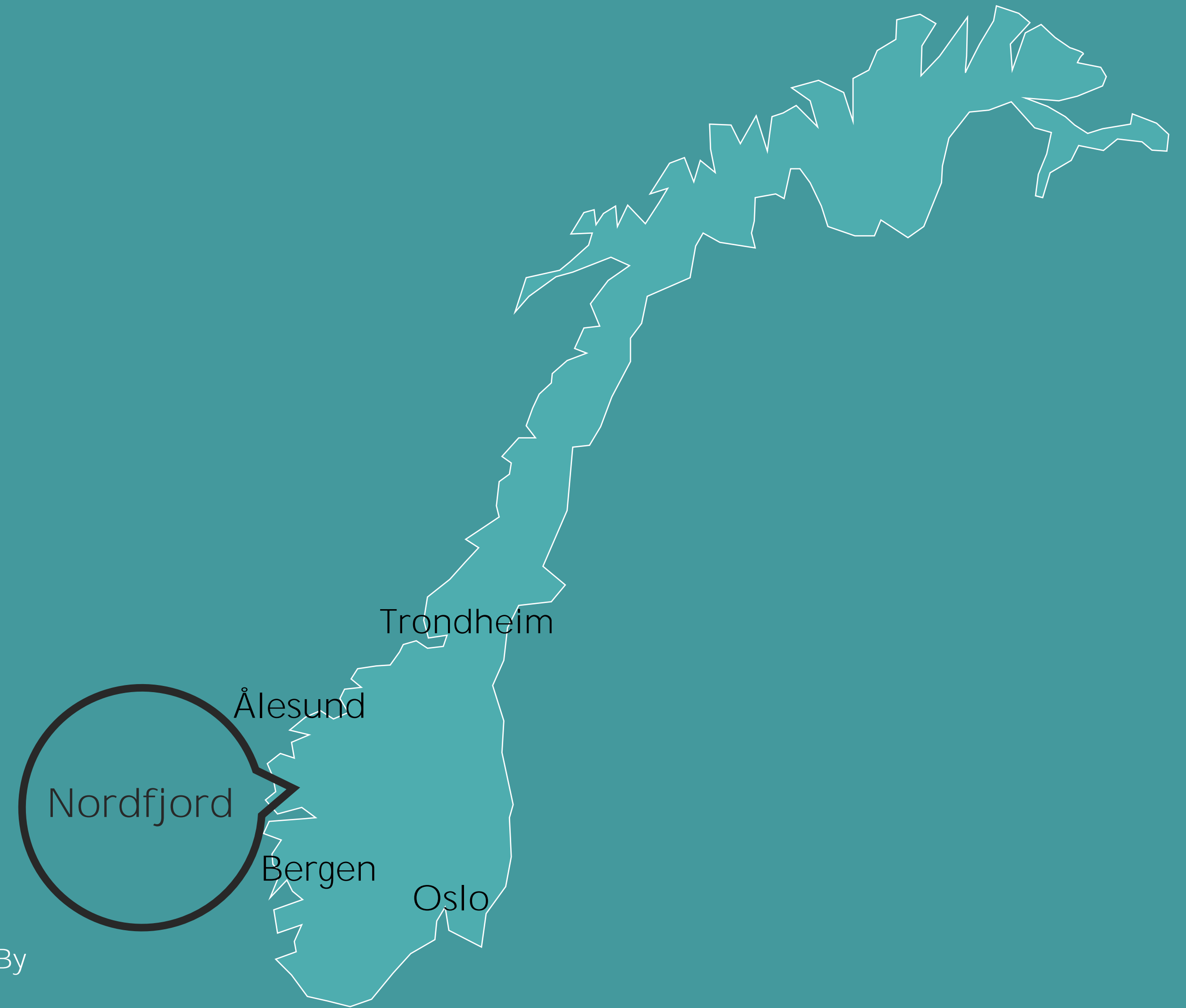

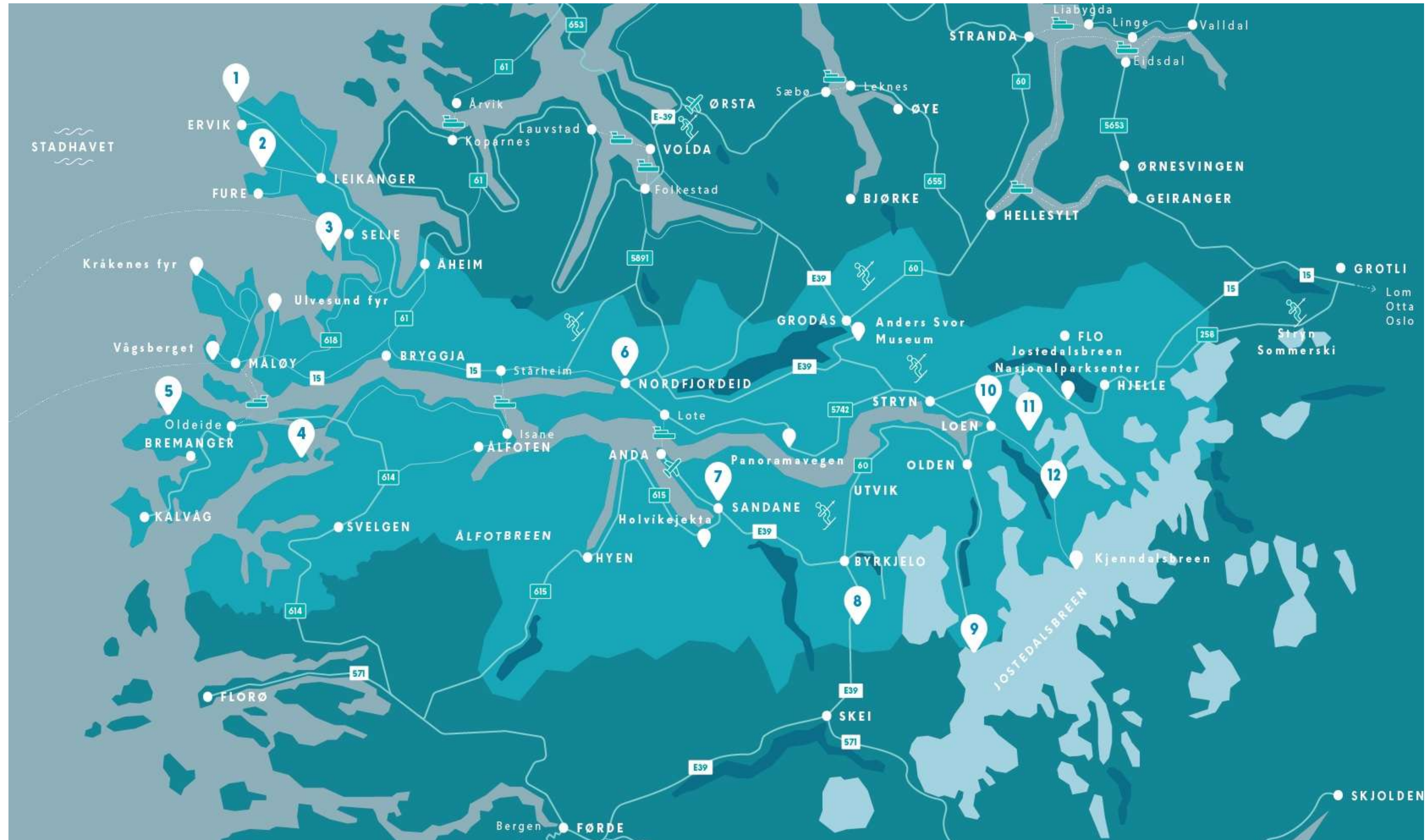

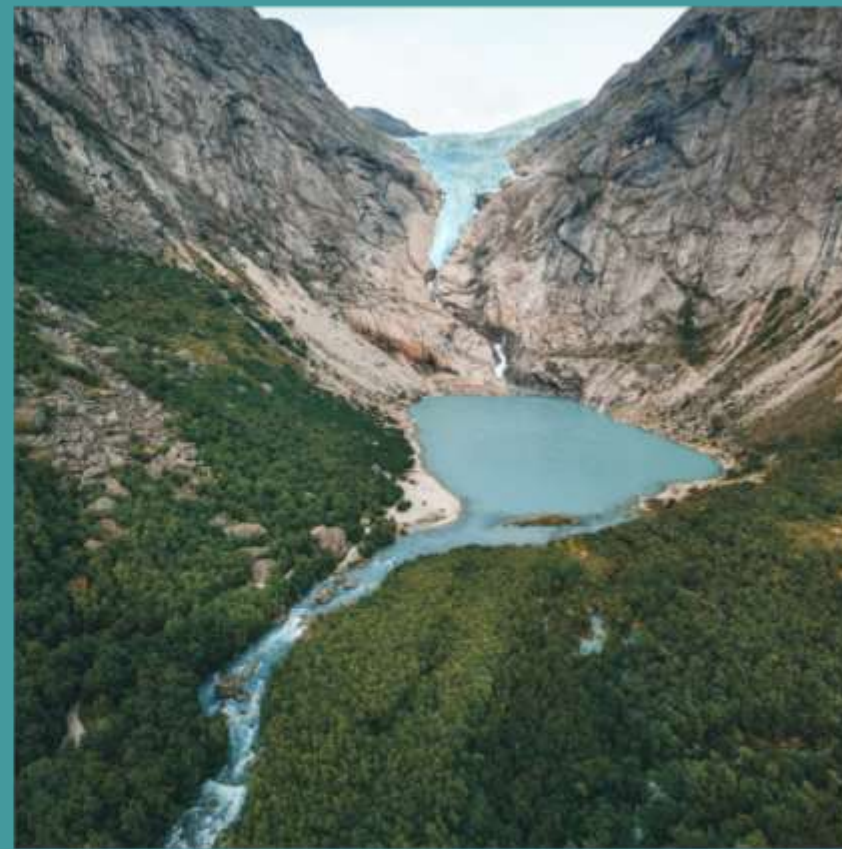

Selja Monastery & The Legend of Saint Sunniva



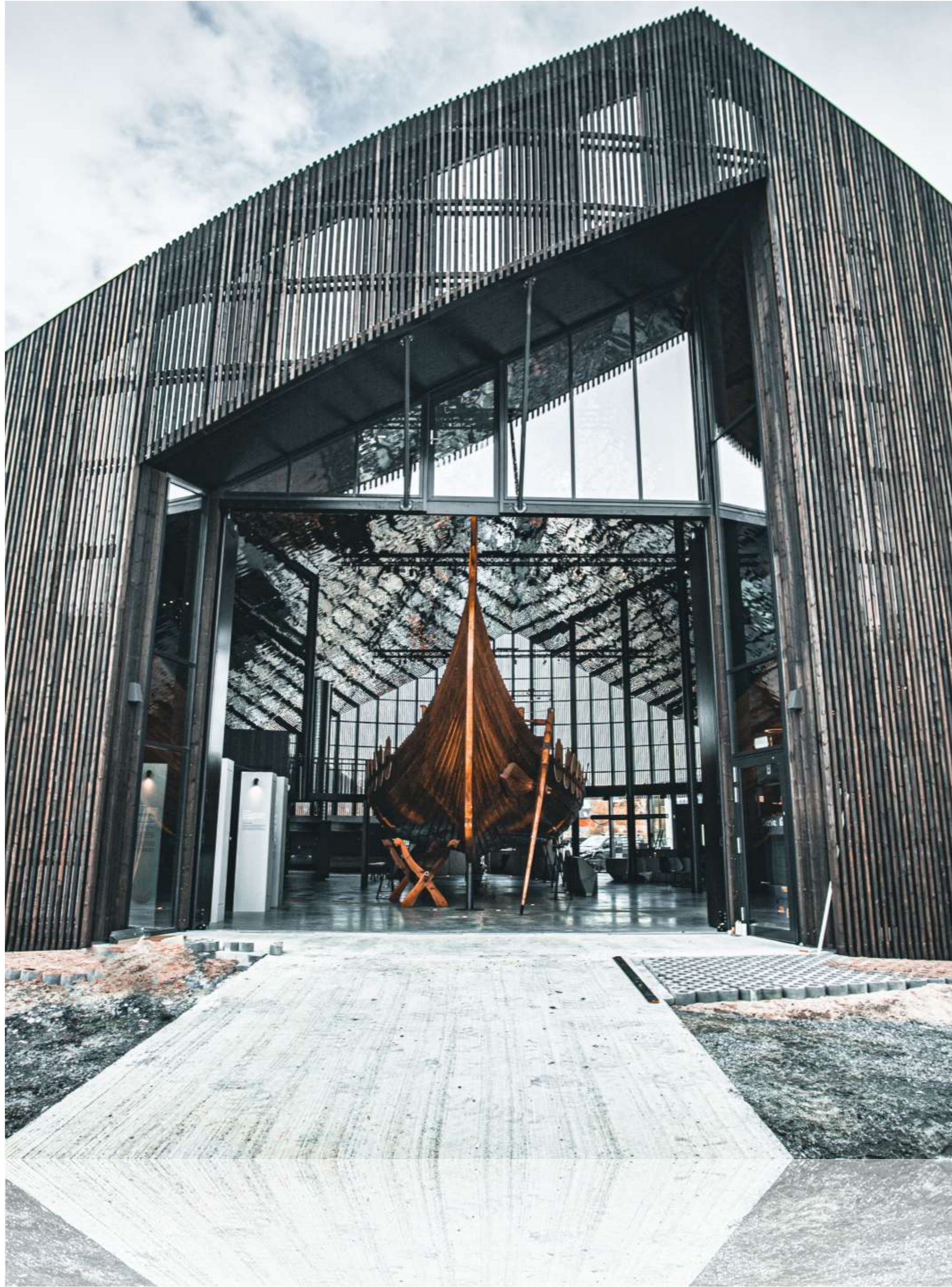
Selja - The Saga Island

The Legend of St. Sunniva

Up from the wild Stadhavet sea, the island of Selja rises as a powerful green cathedral. The Irish Princess Sunniva fled from the Viking, and died in the Sunniva Cave. Ever since then people have been traveling to Selja, Norway's first pilgrimage place, with unique cultural heritage from the Viking Age and the Middle Ages.

Sagastad & The Myklebust Viking Ship



Sagastad Viking Center The Myklebust Viking Ship

Sagastad is a knowledge center focusing on the Viking Age. Here you can explore the 30 meter (100ft) long Myklebust ship - one of the worlds largest viking ships that has been found traces of. Learn about the mystics, the rituals, of the long voyages in fantastic ships and about our proud cultural history.

With one of the countries richest, largest and most spectacular Viking graves in the center of the town, Nordfjordeid is the obvious location for Sagastad.

Walk the Saga-trail to see it all.

Museums & visitor centres

Nordfjord Folk Museum



The Nordfjord Museum of Cultural History. 44 houses and cottages of historical interest from 1600-1900's in an open air museum. The old authentic Norwegian ship «Holvikeyekta». Temporary exhibitions. Daily guided tours in season. Sandane, Gloppen.

Josfedalsbreen National Park

Anders Svor Museum



The renowned sculptor Anders Svor (1864-1929) has his own museum in his home village of Hornindal. Here you will find 450 sculptures. Gallery and sculptor garden. Hornindal.

Holvikejekta



New 2025

Holvikejekta, Nordfjord Folk Museum

June 2025 marked the opening of the new conservation and exhibition building for the only authentic, clinker-built jekt of its kind.

Experience the past: Allow your senses to be awakened by authentic scents from a bygone era. Ramps along the walls of the building allow you to see both below and above the deck of the jekt.

Historical building techniques: Holvikejekta was built using the same techniques as the Viking ships.

Freighter to Bergen: The jekt was used for moving up to 150 fathoms of firewood to Bergen between 1881-1906.

Nordfjord boat exhibition: Learn about Nordfjord's 1000-year-old boat history.

Opening hours: The museum is open during the summer season, and group tours will be available on request throughout the year.

Museums & visitor centres

Måløy Raid Center



The Måløy Raid center is an international war history information and visitor centre, that presents an important part of the Second World War. The center is divided into several themes, and the story is well documented by videos, sound recordings, documents, odors, objects and models. **Måløy, Kinn.**

Farm visits



Farm experiences in Nordfjord offer a glimpse **into the region's rural heritage and living cultural landscape.** They can give visitors a better understanding of how farming traditions, local food and the use of the land have shaped communities through time. Nordfjord Opera House

Víngen Petroglyph

One of the largest fields of petroglyph in Northern Europe. Approx. 2300 petroglyphs or rock carvings that are more than 6,000 years old.

Loen Skylift

From fjord to sky in 5 minutes

A cable car will lift you from the fjord to 1011 m. Enjoy the views of the fjord landscape and Jostedalbreen National Park from the top of the mountain. Loen Skylift is open all year,



Activities at Mount Hoven

Adventure arena at 1011 m.

Loen Skylift will take you to a new adventure arena at 1011 m.a.s.l. Here you will find signposted walking trails, zip lines and in winter; ski touring, cross country skiing, snowshoeing and tobogganing. If you like you can climb the Via Ferrata up to Mt. Hoven. At the top you find Hoven Restaurant.

New Via Ferrata

Hornelen Via Ferrata

The trip takes you 860 meters straight up Europe's highest sea cliff. A brand new climbing route in Bremanger, at the coast of Nordfjord. With air all around you and the sea straight underneath, is this an experience you will not forget!

Hornelen Via Ferrata offers three climbing routes; Olavsruta, Hekseveggen «The wall of witches» and Ørnelia «Eagles Side».

Olavsruta is the whole climbing trail, from sea level to the top.

Hornelen Via Ferrata opened in June 2023.



Breogfjell

Breogfjell offers glacier hike to Haugabreen Glacier. Family friendly.

Season: June - August. Tours can be booked outside season out October. Meeting point at Skei in Jølster.

You will need:

- A small backpack (20-40L)
- Mountain boots. Trainers will not do the job. The soles should be thick and have a good grip, be hard-wearing, waterproof and have a good ankle support.
- Warm clothing for a day in the ice! (layers of wool will keep you warm)
- Insulated jacket like down, fleece or primaloft
- Wind/waterproof clothing
- Gloves/mittens
- Long pants.
- Lunch and a warm beverage
- Sunglasses!

They will provide safety equipment, iceaxe and crampons for you, but you need room in your backpack to carry it up to the glacier.

Sledding



Experience Norway's longest toboggan/sled run - 8 km / 4,5 miles down from Mt. Hoven - with fantastic views of the fjord and mountains. At Mt. Hoven, you will also find a wide prepared toboggan run. Note that the offer is weather-dependent.

Snow Shoeing



Explore the winter landscape by foot, 1011 meters above the fjord. There are many winter walking opportunities around Mt. Hoven, most offering fabulous views of the **fjord and the majestic mountains. And it's all so close, with only a spectacular five minute cable car ride from Loen village.**

Ski Touring



The mountains surrounding Loen and Stryn invite you to great ski touring and backcountry skiing with views of fjords and mountains. With Loen Skylift, you reach 1011 altitude meters and can head out with fresh legs. Ski guides from Breogfjell has internationally certified mountain guides and offers guided tours from Loen Skylift.
